

AUSTIN CHAPTER TRADES SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

ELIGIBILITY

Applicant must be currently indentured or enrolled in (or have been accepted into) a US Department of Labor Office of Apprenticeship registered construction related training/apprenticeship program, technical school in a construction trade or equivalent.

REQUIREMENTS

Applicant is responsible for submitting their signed and completed application form, and financial need essay to the NAWIC Austin Chapter scholarship committee for receipt by **Friday**, **July 26**, **2024**.

AWARDS

- A. NAWIC Austin will award sixteen (16) scholarships for the 2023-2024 Academic year.
 Two (2) \$2,500 Milwaukee Tool Voucher Scholarships; One (1) \$3,000 Marcell Ellison Memorial Scholarship; One (1) \$1,000 Fatima Velazquez Memorial Scholarship; and Thirteen (13) \$2,000 NAWIC Scholarships.
- B. The Austin NAWIC Scholarship Committee will review applications and select winners. The Committee will consider applicant's interest in construction, extracurricular activities, employment experience, and financial need. The Committee will notify all applicants of their status no later than **Friday, September 6, 2024**.
