  2. *Transcripts must be requested in the WHS Registrar's Office. [REDACTED] Transcript requests will require a 2-day turnaround.*
  3. *The completed application must include a personal statement, a resume, and at least 1 letter of recommendation.*
- All applications for scholarship opportunities must be turned in to Mrs. Rugeley in the WHS Administration Office, mailed to the contact listed on the application, hand-carried to the contact listed on the application, or submitted online by the posted deadline date and time.
